Coronavirus outbreak

As a charity we have been looking at ways to support our most vulnerable users during the current coronavirus outbreak.

Please follow NHS and Government advice for more information on the outbreak. We will offer as much local support as we can.

Our aim is to have three clear levels of service:

- 1** For older people unable to leave home and who do not have support from friends or family:
 - Help with basic food shopping
 - Collecting top-up gas and electric cards

- 2** For those who are unwell with Coronavirus and do not have support to cook, we will have a 'crisis intervention service':
 - A cooked meal in a foil container which you will need to re-heat if needed
 - Help with basic food shopping
 - Collecting top-up gas and electric cards

- 3** For parents facing hardship:
 - Delivery of food parcels or basic items that have been donated

We are setting up a 'command centre' for HNCC staff at the Whittington Estate where we will coordinate our efforts. Please note that this is not a drop-in advice service and only those delivering donations of food parcels or basic items will be permitted.
